Sharyn Peterson's students--violinists, violists and vocalists--are performing and teaching in many areas of the world, often in leading roles, and some are currently performing with the Seattle Symphony, the Seattle Rock Orchestra, the Pacific Northwest Ballet, San Diego Symphony, and the Seattle Opera.

Sharyn Peterson has served as violin soloist/concertmaster with Northwest chorales, dance groups, and symphonic ensembles. She has performed in China, Costa Rico, and Washington D.C.--and many other places. In 2004 she co-founded Skagit Opera, and was Concertmaster and orchestra agent for the first five seasons.

Mrs. Peterson has served on the faculties of Seattle Pacific and Western Washington Universities, Skagit Valley College, Sehome High School, Shuksan Middle School, Skagit Family Learning Center, North Seattle Christian School, Cedar Park Christian School, Whatcom Hills Waldorf School, and Greenwood Tree Cooperative School. In 2006 she founded and currently directs the Peterson Conservatory of Music and Arts, in Mt. Vernon, Washington, where she also teaches violin, viola, and voice.
