The EMTA Musicianship Festival (EMF) will be here before you know it! The theme this year is, "The Musical Garden!" (This can mean flowers and gardening, but it can also mean bugs and dirt! Interpret the theme as you see fit!).

This festival will be held on Saturday, May 3rd, and will be a hybrid event with performances and compositions pre-recorded and due on Friday, April 18th. All other events will be live on May 3rd at the Edgewood Baptist Church located at 20406 76th Avenue W, Edmonds, WA 98026.

Students receive a ribbon for each category they enter. They can enter up to eleven events, so they may very well come away with a handful of ribbons!

The Edmonds Music Teachers Association (EMTA) holds this event annually to fund the EMTA Excellence in Music Awards, which includes the Joan E. Brown Scholarship, as well as cover our festival expenses.

Additional Events – Select both if you wish 1. Composition (upload to the Student Upload Form by Friday, April 18th) 2. Projects you create using the subject of MUSIC (Projects can be brought during the actual set-up date, which is Friday, May 2nd during the times of 3:00-5:00 pm, or no later than 8:30 am on Saturday, May 3rd.)
